DEAR MR. SPEAKER: In accordance with the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1801 et seq.), I transmit herewith an Agreement between the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania extending the Agreement of November 12, 1992, Concerning Fisheries Off the Coasts of the United States, with annex, as extended (the 1992 Agreement). The present Agreement, which was effected by an exchange of notes at Vilnius on May 18, 2001, and Washington on December 26, 2001, extends the 1992 Agreement to December 31, 2004.

In light of the importance of our fisheries relationship with the Republic of Lithuania, I urge that the Congress give favorable consideration to this Agreement.

The Department of State wishes to inform the Foreign Ministry of the Republic of Lithuania that the Government of the United States of America accepts the Foreign Ministry's Diplomatic Note 256/2001 regarding the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Lithuania and the Government of the United States of America concerning Fisheries off the Coasts of the United States, with annex, signed at Washington November 12, 1992, as extended (the Agreement), extending the Agreement with the Republic of Lithuania for a three-year period, until December 31, 2004. The United States of America confirms that the Ministry's Note of May 18, 2001 and this Note in reply shall constitute an agreement between the two governments, which shall enter into force on a date to be determined in this subsequent exchange of diplomatic notes following the completion of all necessary international procedures of both parties.
