I am pleased to share this summary of the Land and Water Conservation Fund State Assistance Program for Fiscal Years 2000-2002. In 1964, Congress established the Land and Water Conservation Fund (Public Law 88-578) to provide for the acquisition and development of public lands to meet the needs of all Americans for outdoor recreation and open space. Since its inception, the Fund has successfully conserved several million acres of open space and helped create more than 38,000 state and local park and recreation facilities. Financial support from the Land and Water Conservation Fund has reached state and local parks in virtually every county in the nation. I am especially pleased that over the last two years funding has substantially increased for state governments and local communities.


The collective results of the Land and Water Conservation Fund are a great achievement, a permanent legacy of conservation and recreation, and a bright testament to the power of federal, state and local partnerships. They are also the first step in a new vision for the American landscape: a nationwide outdoor recreation network, a seamless system of parks accessible to all. Through the support of the Land and Water Conservation Fund, we now have thousands of miles of trails for walking, hiking and biking. Acres and acres of protected lands are available for camping and picnicking. Beaches, rivers, lakes and streams are made accessible for swimming, fishing and boating. New and rehabilitated recreation fields are open for baseball, soccer and basketball. The list goes on and on. These parks and open spaces are enhancing the daily lives of millions. Perhaps even more significant, since areas supported by the Fund must be maintained for recreation use in perpetuity, these treasured places are protected permanently, now and for the future.

Project Highlights

Bear Creek Trail, Morrison, Colorado

A new link in metropolitan Denver's burgeoning trails network, Bear Creek Trail is a half-mile multi-use trail for hiking, walking and biking that also enhances access to Morrison's popular Town Park.

Build-A-Dream Park, Andalusia, Alabama

Inspired by the dream of neighborhood mothers who wanted better recreation facilities for children, Build-A-Dream Park has evolved into a community project that has attracted over 2,000 volunteers. The park will feature a large community-built playground, access to a walking trail, restrooms, picnic pavilions, gazebos, a decorative fountain and an open space play area.

Douglas Point-Potomac River, Maryland

Located one hour from the Nation's capital, Douglas Point is one of the most ecologically significant areas in Maryland and was identified as a key component of the state's "green infrastructure." In partnership with the Maryland Department of Natural Resources, Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance helped acquire 5.500 acres of wilderness. bordered by 9.5 miles of unspoiled coastline along the Potomac River, Mattawoman Creek and the historic Port Tobacco River. These lands provide major public access for boaters and fishermen as well as critical refuge for migratory waterfowl, bald eagles, great blue herons and other rare and endangered plant and animal species.

East Coast Greenway Recreational Trail, Daytona Beach, Florida

Development of Daytona Beach's Riverfront Park, a local link on the multi-state East Coast Greenway includes a multi-use trail, security lighting and landscaping. The City will complement these recreation improvements with renovation of a historic home in the park for use as an environmental learning center.

Elkhorn Slough, Watsonville, California

Elkhorn Slough provides excellent opportunities for hiking, kayaking and canoeing. Acquisition of 559 acres of riparian, upland and wetland habitats and cultivated farmland advances implementation of the Elkhorn Slough Watershed Conservation Plan. The plan also calls for technical assistance to farmers to improve resource management.

Lakewood Park/Munster Bike Trail, Munster, Indiana

In a state with one of the highest obesity rates and one of the lowest percentages of land for outdoor recreation, Munster is improving public health by increasing outdoor recreation. The City will acquire an abandoned railroad right-of-way as a link along the 11-mile Munster Bike Trail for running, walking and skateboarding. The project reclaims valuable land in a highly industrialized and congested region of the state, and produces a positive benefit for the community health.

Soldier Hollow, Wasatch Mountain State Park, Utah

Wasatch Mountain State Park was one of the earliest projects in Utah to receive funding from the Land and Water Conservation Fund. This 22,600 acre park provides yearround outdoor recreation and is one of the most heavily used parks in Utah. In 2002, the Soldier Hollow area of the park hosted cross-country and biathlon competitions for the Olympic Winter Games. The state-of-theart trail system is being enhanced with picnic areas, campgrounds and restroom facilities.

Roberto Clemente State Park, New York, New York

An extremely popular and well-loved multiuse recreation area along the Harlem River in the Bronx, this urban state park has received 12 Land and Water Conservation Fund grants since 1968 for ball fields, basketball courts, picnic areas and a riverfront promenade. The current project is for lighting to expand evening recreational opportunities.

Charting the Need for the Land and Water Conservation Fund

In an effort to measure the current need for outdoor recreation facilities and open space acquisition at the state and local level, the National Park Service asked each state in November, 2002, to estimate their total request for Land and Water Conservation Funds for each of the past three fiscal years (2000-2002). If a state typically combines Land and Water Conservation Funds with similar state grant programs, an estimate of the total demand for all programs was used in order to express a more accurate sense of statewide need. With 45 states responding, a strong demand for recreation facility development and open space acquisition emerged: 70% of the responding states reported an unmet funding need exceeding 50%. Since Land and Water Conservation Funds are available to states for three years following appropriation, it is important to note that some states have not fully implemented their apportioned funding.




