## REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 258]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 258, by a nonrecord vote, reports the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

## SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 1268, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Tsunami Relief Act, 2005, and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

The rule also authorizes the chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary to file a supplemental report to accompany H.R. 748, the Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act.

## EXPLANATION OF WAIVERS

The waiver of all points of order against consideration of the conference report includes a waiver of clause 4(a) of rule XIII (requiring a three-day layover of the committee report), which is necessary because the conference report (H. Rept. 108–72) was not filed until Tuesday, May 3, 2005, and the conference report may be considered by the House as early as Thursday, June 9, 2005.
