REPORT

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 565, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the rolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 3058, Departments of Transportation, Treasury, Housing and Urban Development, the Judiciary, the District of Columbia, and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 2006, and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

EXPLANATION OF WAIVERS

The waiver of all points of order against consideration of the conference report includes a waiver of clause 8 of rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of conference reports and the accompanying joint explanatory statement), which is necessary because the conference report (H. Rept. 109–307) was not filed until the legislative day of Thursday, November 17, 2005, and the conference report may be considered by the House as early as the legislative day of Friday, November 18, 2005.
