REPORT

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 1096, by a non-record vote, reports the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a twothirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The resolution applies the waiver to any special rule reported on the legislative day of December 7, 2006.

The rule further provides that suspensions will be in order at any time on the legislative day of December 7, 2006. The rule provides that the Speaker or his designee shall consult with the Minority Leader or her designee on any suspension considered under the rule.

Finally, the rule provides that House Resolution 810, 939, 951, and 1047 are laid upon the table.
