WAIVING POINTS OF ORDER AGAINST THE CONFERENCE REPORT TO ACCOMPANY H.R. 5682, UNITED STATES AND INDIA NUCLEAR COOPERATION PROMOTION ACT OF 2006

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 1101]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 1101, by a nonrecord vote, reports the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 5682, the United States and India Nuclear Cooperation Promotion Act of 2006, and against its consideration. Finally, the rule provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

EXPLANATION OF WAIVERS

The waiver of all points of order is necessary because the conference report was filed with the House on Thursday, December 7, 2006 and it may be considered by the House as early as Friday, December 8, 2006, which would violate clause 8 of rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of conference reports and the accompanying joint explanatory statement).
