## SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides that supensions will be in order at any time on or before the legislative day of Saturday, October 14, 2000. The object of any motion to suspend the rules shall be announced from the floor at least one hour prior to its consideration. The rule further provides that the Speaker or his designee will consult with the Minority Leader or his designee on any suspension considered under this resolution.
