SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration in the House of House Joint Resolution 128, making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2001, under a closed rule. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the joint resolution. The rule also provides one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit.
